

## **Project Update: October, 2018**

During the summer months of 2018, field work was conducted and the traps were regularly visited.

Within the inter-ethnic biological research camp held in NP Kozara, an entomological section was formed through which the students were introduced to the project and actively participated in the collection of samples from 3rd to 6th August 2018. The methodology of the work included the collection of samples from pre-set traps and the research of old and fallen tree trunks. In addition, the night field work was realised.

In October 2018, the last samples for this year were collected, and the cleaning, sorting, photographing and determination of the collected material began and is still in progress.

In the past months, promotional materials of the project, cotton bags, t-shirts and magnets have been made and are actively spread at various activities implemented by the project coordinator as well as on behalf of Center for the Environment.
