Project Activities

As winter temperatures did not allow field activities, we focused on getting equipment and gave talks about the project in several opportunities. We also continue greenhouse activities with the first group of trees.

- Purchases: seedling trays, hole digging and regular spades, hoes, phosphorous fertiliser, perlite, accessory components for the greenhouse.

- During other project activities, we travel to North Entre Rios province, where we found agricultural producers interested in our project. They have abandoned agricultural fields and they are now trying to recover the original forest in that area. We may start some tests in their fields in the next season. During the visit to agricultural high school in Gualeguaychhu, teachers who run a greenhouse at the school contacted us for advice and probable joint activities.
