

Project Update: May 2019

The workshop "Las pavas de monte de las Yungas Australes" was given by Yanina Tejerina and Gabriela Dominguez at school No. 309 Pedro O. de Zarate, in the town of El Fuerte, Santa Bárbara Department, Province of Jujuy - Argentina. This was carried out thanks to the grant awarded by The Rufford Foundation. In the talk, 4th grade students and the director of that establishment participated. We worked with sheets that contained images of the two species of turkeys; the activity consisted in the identification of the two species of turkeys that are found in the Austral Yungas, their morphological characteristics, distribution and location in the altitudinal gradient of the Yungas, the function of them in the jungle, and their threats. Then they put into practice what they had learnt and the children captured it through drawings, painting with the characteristic colours of each species of pava highlighting the differences between them.
