Camera-trap survey:

We have already recorded two of the three focus species (Galictis cuja and Eira barbara)




Left: Teutônia landscape. Right: Eira barbara, Turvo State Park. ©Neotropical Mustelids Project

We concluded the sampling in the three study areas previously mentioned in the application and, in addition, we included two new areas of interest to increase our preservation gradient and improve our results. This areas are: an unprotected area in Teutônia Municipality - Rio Grande do Sul (29°S 22'54.5"S/51° 47'03.7"W) where the Atlantic Forest suffers from intense degradation due to land use for agriculture and livestock and the National Forest of Passo Fundo (28°18'51.11"S/ 52°11'18.05"W) which is a Conservation Unit with different landscapes and environments from that which we have already sampled.

Chemical profiles:

We completed the milling and drying process of all fecal samples in the laboratory. In the next quarter, I must perform the next step that is identify the chemical profiles.
