Project Update: January 2019

We have successfully completed the fieldwork.

We visited the central, southern (Aysén region) and extreme southern (Magallanes region) areas of Chile, collecting more than 1000 moult feathers from 22 roosts. The central zone is less represented so we will be looking for more roosts during this month and DNA extraction will begin next month.
