

Project Update: January 2020

We have successfully finished important initial steps to initiate the Guariba howler monkey group monitoring. The groups were identified and selected for monitoring and the animals were habituated to the presence of the observing researcher. In addition, we installed fruit traps, marked feeding trees and installed two thermohygrometers. After all these steps, we began monthly monitoring of the two selected groups. These first months correspond to the hottest and driest period of the year and we followed monthly monitoring over the next few months (wettest period of the year).
