Project Update: September 2019

For the last 8 months, I have been visiting 60 riparian study sites, five times each one (we have one pending visit). As of September 2019, I have already registered a total of 19 amphibian species. At each visit, I have been recording air temperature and moisture. I have recorded some threatened amphibian species, such as Ithsmura belli (Fig 1A), Aquiloeurycea longicauda (Fig 1B), Ambystoma ordinarium (Fig 1C), and Craugastor pygmaeus (Fig 1D)!

In the following month, I would be analysing the data obtaining some results at the end of 2019.
