
## **Project Update: September 2019**

We made three field campaigns to three national parks in north-west Argentina.

In each campaign, we installed three automatic recording devices that will monitor the breeding activity of the aimed marsupial frogs (*Gastrotheca gracilis* in Aconquija National Park, *Gastrotheca chrysosticta* in Baritú National Park and in hope of finding Gastrotheca *christiani* in Calilegua National Park).



In Baritú National Park, we recorded reproductive calls of *Gastrotheca chrysosticta* males. And deployed a second automated recorder on a new population found nearby.



Also, we undertook the first field workshop in Aconquija National Park involving the training of park rangers in acoustic monitoring. Likewise, we posted weekly our field campaigns and work done on our social media pages (Facebook: CANOA, Instagram: canoa\_anfibios).
