Project Update: October 2019

Considering that our project was approved in July 2019 we had to make some changes in timescale. Officially, start of the project is planned for 1st May 2019 but we move some activities for the next year.

During the first period of the project all known habitat of *Tilio-Acerion* forests of slopes, screes and ravines in the area have been studied in order to collect material (herbarium, photos) as well as to collecting about 35 phytocenological relevés and place five permanent sample plots, studying floristic composition of the target habitat type.

In each of the two canyons, five permanent sample plots are established at each locality, photographed and its center recorded by GPS device.

Previously, we organized introductory meetings with administrations of the Forest Management Agence "Lisina" and "Čemernica" where introduced them to our activities and taking the appropriate maps and permits. The initial meeting with the two management agencies showed great interest and need for the upcoming research activities.
