

Project Update: May 2020

We have completed collection for both ecological and local stakeholders' perception data. We interviewed 157 local people in eight buffer villages (i.e. Ranupani, Jarak Ijo, Gubuklakah, Jajang, Poncokusumo, Bedo Lawang, Pandansari and Wonorejo).

From December 14th -15th 2019, I attended the International Conference of Biodiversity in Lombok, Indonesia where I presented some of the results of the project. Furthermore, from January 10th – 13th 2020 I attended the Rufford Small Grant Conference in Penang, Malaysia. I presented the project and also an education video titled "Get to know Javan lutung". This video was produced to raise local children's knowledge about Javan lutung. We collaborated with local community called Gubug Embun in producing this video.

We are finishing the education strategy and writing some articles related to the projects to be sent out to journals. We were supposed to discuss the final strategy with the stakeholders', however we had to postpone it due to COVID-19 pandemic. We will resume the project after the pandemic ends.
