Project Update: May 2022

The fieldwork phase was between October 2021 and February 2022. The team installed automated recorders (Audiomoths) and temperature and humidity recorders (Dataloggers) at 72 sampling points in four protected areas located in the south of Brazil: São Francisco de Paula National Forest, Aparados da Serra National Park, Serra Geral National Park and the PRÓ-MATA Center for Research and Conservation of Nature. In addition, we obtained the data associated with the environmental covariates for each sampling point, including temperature, humidity, precipitation, cloud cover, phase of the moon, percentage of moonlight, sunset and sunrise times.
