I am happy to inform you that, after a gigantic effort, the installation of the entire system is completed. Only the final warning lights (one at the start and one at the end) need to be installed. The location for the warning light should be identified by the forest department and we are waiting for their initiative. This month the project should be over, and I will send you the final report with a video. I am also pleased to inform you our project is getting documented by the National Geographic Tamil Nadu representative. At the same time, I also want to inform you that already four poles are down (three by elephant and one by bison) but we have already re-installed those.
