Project Update: October 2022

Updates on project advancement (05/10/22)

We have started field work with a recce in August and September 2022 to find a suitable site for collaring our species of interest in Sabah. The area proposed so far for collaring different individuals of colugos are UMS campus or Shangri-La Rasa Ria in Kota Kinabalu who both have a healthy population of Sunda colugos and have also forest and disturbed areas to compare the animal's behaviour and analyse how they adapt to disturbed areas. The final site is still in discussion, and it will depend on access permission.

We will also change our plans from implants to collar as we discussed from a vet from Singapore Zoo and the colugos seems to be fine wearing a collar and they do not need a long antenna as they have a small home range. We will use the model Ultimate Lite Collar Range specifically made for small mammals, lightweight and with a lifespan of around 1 year.

We will start our collaring and behavioural follow activities in January 2023. Here is a timeline of activities proposed.
