

Project Update: October 2021

First fieldwork campaign (August - September).

During the 4 weeks that I spent in the provinces of Santa Fe and Santiago del Estero (August - September), I reached a huge number of people. The data I am about to write down is still provisional (an estimation), since it needs revision, breakdown and classification, and I will present the final data in an Excel in the final report.

1. Schools: I gave around 50 talks at schools, reaching around 1000 students from primary level (aged 6-12) and more than 1000 students from secondary level (aged 13-18). Additionally, I reached around 100 students from university (or tertiary) levels (more than 18 years old) and around 50 kids from kindergarten (aged 3-5). Most of these schools and institutes were based in towns and villages of less than 5000 inhabitants.
2. Rural Workers, Producers and Local Inhabitants: we also gave more than 10 talks which were directed to rural workers and producers, professional ornithologists, local inhabitants and other authorities, reaching more than 200 people. Last but not least, we have already conducted personal (individual) interviews with around 40 rural workers.
3. Media: our project has already appeared in five local newspapers, three local TV channels and four radio programmes.

Attached, you will find some pictures showing my work at schools, local councils, meetings with producers and other talks. I am now gathering more information concerning our media appearances. Hoping that I have given enough information to you on my advances on this project, I look forward to hearing from your response. Es grande, alcanzando la hembra de 80 a 85 cm y el macho de 75 a 79 cm de longitud. Tiene alas largas y anchas, y la cola corta. La cabeza es de color concolorado con una cresta prominente y nutrida. El dorso es grisáceo, y el vientre gris moteado de pardo. El águila coronada es una de las águilas más grandes de Argentina, encontrándose en las sabanas y bosques del centro.
