On 7th December, a half day workshop was organized for the school coordinators of six schools, at Sringery LS School. During the workshop, the coordinators were given a set of guidelines, webs of five themes, worksheets and questionnaires, basic science equipment, etc.

They are asked to go through the worksheets and questionnaires and see where they could link with subjects like Science, Social and Environmental studies. They were also given the timeline of the work, fieldwork, mode of monitoring and assessment, meetings, exhibitions and follow up work.
