Through the help of the chief, we have managed to form five groups consisting of 20 community members. The groups are mixed consisting of women, youth and men. While some are solely youth groups and women groups like "Rid Wiyi" women group. The project aims at forming 10 groups of 20 community members by the end of the mobilisation exercise.
