Project Update: December 2023


Status of the project

All activities planned so far have been carried out. Six sampling campaigns were carried out in which water and faecal material from wild animal samples were taken, as well as monitoring the diversity of large and medium-sized mammals with camera traps. Two more workshops were held for the community of Villa Serrana regarding the environmental problems. In addition, we carried out a historical analysis of land use. Monitoring of water, faeces and mammals will continue, and another workshop will be held with the community and the school of Villa Serrana. Moreover, we have been interviewed by the press and published in the newspaper "La Diaria", the note is attached.
