

### **Project Update: November 2008**

We are presently continuing sea turtle conservation work on Nevis. The nesting season is not yet finished and we are continuing to conduct morning and evening surveys. Two student volunteers continue to work with us conducting surveys and putting the data together so that it will be easier for us to complete our report this year. On the 16th of November 2008 we were hit by Hurricane Omar which came out of the Caribbean Sea to the west of the island. All nests on west coast beaches appeared to have been completely destroyed (we can find none). However, we lost only one nest on the index beach that is on the north coast (Lovers Beach) and south coast beaches suffered no damage. Nesting should come to an end by early December.
