This is a progress report of the project "Biodiversity Conservation for the People by the People: awareness raising and capacity building project in the buffer zone of Chitwan National Park, Nepal". This project was implemented in 29th September 2008, aimed on awareness raising and capacity building of local communities, youths, students and underprivileged ethnic groups to support biodiversity conservation through sustainable management of buffer zone forest, grassland and park ecosystem as a whole.

As per the program schedule, a bunch of activities have already been conducted, i.e. formation of Tribal Ethnic Group and then its legal registration as an NGO-named: "Tribal Society for Biodiversity Conservation-TSBC Nepal"; publication of brochure and educational material (diary); and school teaching program (10 schools have already been taught).
