Project Update: October 2004

Our team members Tsewang Namgail and Sumanta Bagchi spent a few months in summer 2004 in the field and Namgail is presently in the field collecting winter data on the Gazelle.

We have obtained a better assessment of gazelle population in the area, its seasonal ranges and impacts of human disturbance on their survival. Besides this, we have confirmed the presence of the Tibetan Argali (Ovis Ammon Hodgsonii), a globally threatened sheep from the area.
