Project Update: February 2010

We have recorded several species of birds in Muara Angke Wildlife Reserve not recorded since 2000. These include spotted kestrel (*Falco moluccensis*), copper-throated sunbird (*Nectarinia calcostetha*) and purple-backed starling (*Sturnus sturninus*). Moreover, based on the survey results in January 2010, we have mapped the distribution of black-winged starling (*Sturnus melanopterus*) and Javan coucal (*Centropus nigrorufus*) in Muara Angke Wildlife Reserve and Angke Kapuk Preserved Forest. In December 2009, we held environment education facilitator training for the public, to encourage them to take part in the campaign of preserving Jakarta's coastal environment.
