Project Update: February 2011

The following activities have been accomplished or are in progress:

- 1. The first round of training was held. Fishermen and game guards from Dezful city and also the Department of Environment of Khuzestan province attended the workshop. Participants learned about *Rafetus euphraticus*, its habitats and how they can get directly involved to help protect this endangered turtle.
- 2. Six training courses were held between August 2010 and February 2011 on "Euphrates softshell turtle conservation" and 272 students in villages of Dezful city, where the turtle exist, attended.
- 3. The Euphrates softshell turtle brochure and painting exhibition announcement were distributed in Dezful city schools during February 2011.
- 4. We have purchased radio telemetry equipment and our activity season for tagging turtles begins at the end of March 2011. A vet professor will help our research team to attach transmitters to the carapace and also to x-ray turtles with portable equipment to detect gravid females during the nesting season.
