Project Update: December 2009

Oxystigma msoo seedlings have already been transplanted in Rau Forest Reserve on open spaces. Seedlings were transplanted in Forest on 24th November 2009 by Kaloleni and Njoro villagers. Seeds were sown in the nursery July 2009, therefore seedlings have stayed in nursery for about five months.

Irrigation in the nursery has been done twice a day for the first two months and once for two days for the third month and once per week for the fourth and fifth months. Monitoring of transplanted seedlings in Rau Forest has now started.
