

## Project Update: December 2010

CATCA has been very busy with our internet monitoring on the trade of capuchin monkeys and other primates in Latin America. We have found chimpanzees, gibbons, langurs, vervets, different species of macaques and other species of primates.

We have had to look for some primate specialists to help us identify some pictures of infant primates. That was a big challenge, because we could not find any primate expert of Latin America species in Canada. We found some of the best primate experts worldwide but they had some problems to recognise some species because the primates are dressed up as baby humans covering most of their bodies and the quality of the pictures are of poor quality. The IUCN Primate Specialist Group kindly agreed to help us. We are very grateful to them for analysing and identifying all the pictures. We are now making a new compilation of pictures to identify.
