




Guanacaste Mammal Tracks

Jaguar,
(*Panthera onca*)

Eng- 9,5cm Round toes. Nocturnal and diurnal, mostly terrestrial and solitary. Biggest cat in America. Esp- 9,5cm Dedos redondeados. Nocturno y diurno, mayormente terrestre y solitario. Es el felino más grande de América.

Puma

(*Puma concolor*)
Eng- 6cm Egg-shaped toes. Nocturnal and diurnal, solitary. Esp- 8cm Dedos en forma de huevo. Nocturno y diurno, solitario.

Ocelot, Ocelote

(*Leopardus pardalis*)
Eng- 5cm Nocturnal and diurnal, mostly terrestrial, solitary. Esp- 5cm Nocturno y diurno. Principalmente terrestre, solitario.

Jaguarundi

(*Puma yagouaroundi*)
Eng- 3cm Toes are slightly more elongated than those of the Margay. Mostly diurnal, terrestrial and solitary. Esp- 3cm Dedos ligeramente más largos que los del Margay. Principalmente diurno, terrestre y solitario.

Margay

(*Leopardus wiedii*)
Eng- 3cm Big eyes, large tail. Mostly nocturnal, terrestrial and arboreal, solitary. Esp- 3cm Ojos grandes, cola larga. Principalmente nocturno, terrestre y arbóreo, solitario.



Common Opossum,
Zorro Pelón
(*Didelphis marsupialis*)
(*Didelphis virginiana*)
Eng- 6,5cm Whit a tail mark.
Nocturnal, mostly terrestrial and solitary. Esp- 6,5cm Marca de la coda en las huellas. Nocturno, principalmente terrestre y solitario.



Central American
Wool y Opossum,
Zorro
(*Caluromys laevigatus*)
Eng- 3cm wide, Nocturnal, arboreal, solitary. Esp- 3cm de ancho, nocturno, arbóreo y solitario.



Water Opossum,
Zorro
(*Chironectes minimus*)
Eng- 5cm Mostly nocturnal, only aquatic opossum, solitary. Esp- 5cm Principalmente nocturno, único zorro acuático, solitario.



Northern Tamandua,
Oso Hormiguero
(*Tamandua mexicana*)
Eng- 4,5cm Diurnal and nocturnal, arboreal arid terrestrial, solitary. Esp- 4,5cm Durante la noche y diurno, arbóreo y terrestre, solitario.



Nine- Banded Long
Nosed Armadillo,
Armadillo
(*Dasypus novemcinctus*)
Eng- Mostly nocturnal, terrestrial and solitary. Esp- Principalmente nocturno, terrestre y solitario.



Central American
Agouti, Guatusa
(*Dasyprocta punctata*)
Eng- Jam Durral, terrestrial and territorial. Esp- Jam Diurno, terrestre y territorial.

Poco, lepezcuitle
(*Agothi poco*)
Eng- Sem Nocturnal, terrestrial and territorial. Esp- Sem Nocturno, terrestre y territorial.

Rabbit, Cone o
(*Sylvilagus brasiliensis*)
(*Sylvilagus flaviventris*)
Eng- 2cm Mostly subsocial terrestrial and solitary. Esp- 2cm Principalmente nocturno, terrestre y solitario.

Northern Raccoon,
Mapache
(*Procyon lotor*)
Eng- 6cm Mostly subsocial, terrestrial and arboreal, mostly solitary. Esp- 6cm Principalmente nocturno, terrestre y arbóreo, principalmente solitario.

White- nosed Coati,
Pizote
(*Nasua narica*)
Eng- 4,5cm Diurnal, terrestrial and arboreal, males solitary, females and young social. Esp- 4,5cm Diurno, terrestre y arbóreo, machos solitarios, hembras y jóvenes sociales.

White-tailed Kinkajou, Coendú
(*Brachycterus canescens*)
Eng- 4,5cm Nocturnal, arboreal, mostly nocturnal, terrestrial and solitary. Esp- 4,5cm Nocturno, terrestre y arbóreo, nocturno, solitario.

White-nosed Coati, Chancho
(*Nasua narica*)
Eng- 4,5cm Diurnal and nocturnal, terrestrial, groups of 50 to 200 individuals. Esp- 4,5cm Diurno y nocturno, terrestre, grupos de 50 a 200 individuos.

Striped Hog- Nosed Skunk, Zorro hediondo
(*Coendou semirufus*)
Eng- 5,5cm Nocturnal, terrestrial and solitary. Esp- 5,5cm Nocturno terrestre y solitario.

White-Tailed Deer, Venado Cola Blanca
(*Odocoileus virginianus*)
Eng- 4,5cm Diurnal and nocturnal, terrestrial, solitary or in small groups. Esp- 4,5cm Diurno y nocturno, terrestre, solitario o en grupos pequeños.



Baird's Tapir, Danta
(*Tapirus bairdii*)

Eng- 17cm Nocturnal and Diurnal, terrestre y solitario. Esp- 17cm Nocturno y diurno, terrestre y solitario.



Teyra, Tolamico
(*Fair barbara*)

Eng- 8cm Diurnal, terrestrial and arboreal. Solitary or in pairs. Esp- 8cm Diurno, terrestre y arbóreo. Solitario o en parejas.



Collared Peccary, Señina

(*Pecari tajacu*)
Eng- 4cm Bluno, esas solitarias, terrestriales, grupos de 30 individuos. Esp- 4cm Diurno y nocturno, terrestre, grupos de 30 individuos.



Neotropical River Otter, Nurria
(*Lontra longicaudis*)

Eng- 8cm Diurnal and nocturnal, porcino and terrestrials. Solitary or small family groups. Esp- 8cm Diurno y nocturno, acuáticos y terrestres. Solitario o en grupos familiares pequeños.



White-Lipped Peccary, Chancho

(*Tayassu pecari*)
Eng- 4,5cm Diurnal and nocturnal, terrestrials, groups of 50 to 200 individuals. Esp- 4,5cm Diurno y nocturno, terrestre, grupos de 50 a 200 individuos.



Striped Hog- Nosed Skunk, Zorro hediondo

(*Coendou semirufus*)
Eng- 5,5cm Nocturnal, terrestrial and solitary. Esp- 5,5cm Nocturno terrestre y solitario.



White-Tailed Deer, Venado Cola Blanca

(*Odocoileus virginianus*)
Eng- 4,5cm Diurnal and nocturnal, terrestrial, solitary or in small groups. Esp- 4,5cm Diurno y nocturno, terrestre, solitario o en grupos pequeños.
