During the training of 60 local leaders from six remaining sectors ICOSCAD has made improvements including reserving more time for local leaders to ask questions and sufficiently answer the wrap-up questions given to them after the session. Thus, ongoing monitoring and evaluation is seeing a great understanding and much commitment among trained leaders which allowing them to properly spread the information and coordinate the stoves construction activities.

Beside this ongoing monitoring ICOSCAD is taking advantage of conferences and exhibitions to share its experience with different stakeholders and also inviting different media partners including radio stations, newspapers and national television to market its activities and achievements.
