Data collected under the Rufford Small Grants Foundation is complete and I am compiling data. I will have my final report to you by the end of the year, including all articles and news sources that covered the research funded by you. The data is very exciting and is hoping to have a publishable scientific article completed by the end of January on the research. I am currently working on Sea World Conservation grant for next year, and do intend to apply for more Rufford funding once my commitment under this first grant is complete. The number of crocs we rescued this year is astounding. And, Dr. Frank Mazzotti is working with me on getting permits through the University of Florida to export the scute samples that I collected under your funding for toxicity testing the first of next year.
