

Project Update: July 2011

The project team was successfully established, and all necessary equipment was bought. Between 21 April and 31 July 2011, 83 man/days of field survey were conducted (32 In Nakhchivan region and 51 In Gobustan region).

During field survey, 15 nests of Egyptian vulture were found in eight sites in Nakhchivan, and five nests and seven pairs of Egyptian vultures were found in the Gobustan region. Every nest had one chick and breeding success was almost 100 %. GPS coordinates and other relevant data about every nest were taken.

A total of 1500 information leaflets were created and almost 100 were distributed during field work between representatives of local communities, necessary explanatory work was done.

Now we began work for preparation of map of distribution on the base of GPS data and other components of database.
