Project Update: December 2012

Our team has visited six schools in December 2012 to create awareness about the importance of local seagrass beds and how it support local fishery, insisting conservation.

The name of schools are:

- 1. Mallipattinam Middle School
- 2. Mallipattinam Primary School
- 3. Chinnamanai Middle School
- 4. Sethubhavachatram Primary School
- 5. Pillyarthidal Middle School
- 6. Sarabendrarajan Pattinam Primary School.

For primary schools, our team spends more time on describing what is seagrass, and how fishes living and breeding there. As a follow up, we will conduct drawing competitions on local seagrass species in these schools in January 2013.

A total number of 636 students were participated in our seagrass awareness events, which is more than the planned project objective (500 students).
